

Whereas - Waterloo Acres Community Association is a Group A water system serving more than fifteen full time residents.

Whereas - Waterloo Acres Community Association's water system existed before the Public Water System Coordination Act of 1977, -and- it has not sought an increase in service connections, -and- it is not currently experiencing problems due to capacity... per WAC 246-290-100 2b the Waterloo Acres Community water system is not required to create, approve, and maintain a formal water system plan as outlined in the aforementioned chapter.

Whereas - RCW 246-290-105 requires community water systems to develop and implement a small water system management program when a formal water system plan is not required.

Therefore the following new section shall be enacted within the Waterloo Acres Community Association By-Laws.

Article V Section VI:

The Board of Directors shall create & maintain a Small Water System Management Program satisfying the requirements of WAC 246-290-105. Members of the Corporation shall comply with notification, disclosure, and inspection requirements deemed necessary to the successful implementation and maintenance of this program.
